# Facts

## Significant accomplishments:

- Partnered with Wayland Baptist Church's Hugs and Kisses Summer Program to *advance* computer awareness/skills training for children and youth
- Partnered with Microsoft Unlimited Potential (MUP) to bring Microsoft Specialists and Unlimited Potential training to local residents and worshippers.
- Partnered with Maryland United States Attorney General's Office, Institute of Law and Justice, University of Maryland Harambee Treatment Center and others to *advance access*/training of computer technology, primarily for residents of Osewgo Mall and residents/worshippers in surrounding Park Heights communities.
- Partnered with Department of Justice, Community Capacity Development Office and others to implement a five-year Weed and Seed Strategy that in 2004:
  - *Advanced* direct services, i.e., after-school academic enhancement, computer training, education services to 191 youth. Over 70% met or exceeded program goals.
  - Provided direct services, i.e., Pre-GED, computer training and education services to 263 adults. Over 85% met or exceeded program objectives.
  - Community residents and worshippers made more than 1,100 visits to Weed & Seed Safe Haven.

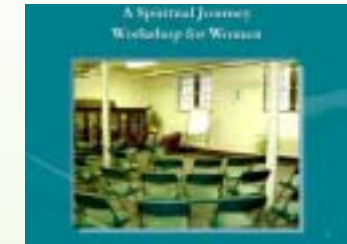

√ Using state-of-the art technology, Project Garrison NW Baltimore Technology Centers offer computer *access* and training for residents and worshippers of communities served.

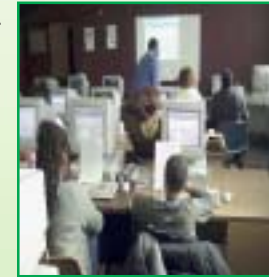
### General Usage
